Climatologic Snow Depth Information	CLISNO	The Northwest Weather and Avalanche Center issues this around the 1 <sup>st</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> of each month November through May. Snow depths are provided for 11 mountain locations.
Daily Climate Summary	CLI (SEA,OLM, SEW,UIL) CDUS46	Issued twice daily, this is a report of the previous day's weather, including maximum and minimum temperature, heating and cooling degree days, precipitation, and wind data for Sea-Tac, WFO Seattle, Olympia and Quillayute.
Earthquake Information Report	EQR SEUS66	Whenever an earthquake of intensity IV or greater on the Modified Mercalli Scale is detected by NWS personnel, this report is issued to provide a brief description. The USGS National Earthquake Information Center (NEIC) issues more specific statements after seismic events also.
Free Text Message	FTM NOUS66	This product gives status changes to the NEXRAD WSR-88D status (operational, down for maintenance, etc). Unlike most other products, the nine letter identifier uses the radar IDs (i.e. SEAFTMATX for the Camano Island radar operated by NWS Seattle).
Monthly Climate Report	CLM CSUS03	Issued on the first of each month, this report provides a summary of the previous month's weather at the same locations for which the CLI products are issued.
Mountain Pass Report	STO SXUS46	Mountain weather conditions as provided by the Washington Dept of Transportation

Public Information Statement	PNS NOUS46	<p>Non-hazardous events and/or general interest information regarding service changes, weather conditions for special events, and monthly/yearly climate related reports all issued here. Also used to for the monthly Washington Precipitation Summary.</p>
Record Event Report	RER SXUS99	<p>This report is issued when a new temperature, rainfall, or snowfall record is set at a weather station for which long-time records are maintained.</p>
Regional Temperature and Precipitation Table	RTP ASUS66	<p>Twice daily issued summation of regional maximum and minimum temperatures and 24 hour precipitation totals/snowfall. Snow depth is included if available.</p>
Regional Weather Roundup	RWR ASUS46	<p>Automatically generated product featuring weather conditions at numerous locations grouped according to zones within the region.</p>
Hydrologic Outlook (Water Supply Outlook)(Spring Flood Outlook)	ESF FGUS76	<p>Discussion of regional precipitation, snowpack, and streamflows as they relate to upcoming seasonal water supplies and/or the potential for spring snow melt flooding. (Also serves as the flood or drought potential outlook.) Usually issued once a month, unless more frequent updates are warranted.</p>

Monthly Hydrometeorological Data Summary	HYM CSUS46	<p>Monthly Summary of precipitation and temperatures for select locations across Western Washington.</p>
Tsunami Information Statements	TIB WEPA43	<p>Issued by the Alaska Tsunami Warning Center and retransmitted by the Seattle or Portland</p>

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
